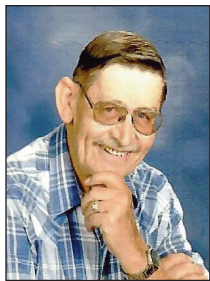


CARNEY, David Alan 8 Jul 1947-
